



POLICY: Uniform

The Dartmoor Primary School colours are red, mid blue and navy blue.

- Mid blue polo shirt with logo (available to be purchased from school)
- Red polar fleece windcheater with logo (available to be purchased from school)
- Red polar fleece vest with logo (available to be purchased from school)
- Navy blue shorts (available to be purchased from school)
- Navy blue skirt/skorts
- Navy blue tracksuit pants
- Navy and white check summer dress
- Plain black or white socks

Terms 1 and 4

- Dartmoor Primary School supply one Red broad brimmed hat per student that has the school logo and Student's name embroidered on it. Families requiring a replacement hat will be invoiced to cover the cost of approximately \$20.
- No hat, no play as per Sunsmart policy.

Terms 2 and 3

- T2 and T3 School Beanies (provided by school).

All Terms

- Hair accessories (ties, bands etc) red or blue. The accessories should not create unnecessary attention for the student.
- Footwear – Runners, black lace-ups, black elastic sided boots. For safety reasons, footwear should have enclosed toes.
- Jewellery/accessories. For safety reasons, studs and sleepers are best for school.

Similarly, if any such items interfere with activities or safety, teachers may request they be removed.

Casual Dress Days

- On these days, safety is paramount, so appropriate footwear is required. (Thongs and sandals do not meet this criteria)

- Clothing that leaves an excessive amount of flesh exposed does not meet with our Sunsmart policy
- Baseball caps may be worn in Terms 2 and 3.

Additional Considerations

- When a child is out of uniform, a note from parent/guardian is required.
- Clothing on these days should be close to school colours.
- In order to represent our school, full uniform is to be worn on all occasions when students leave the school, unless parents are otherwise informed in the excursion note.
