Canoe Day Tuesday 6 December

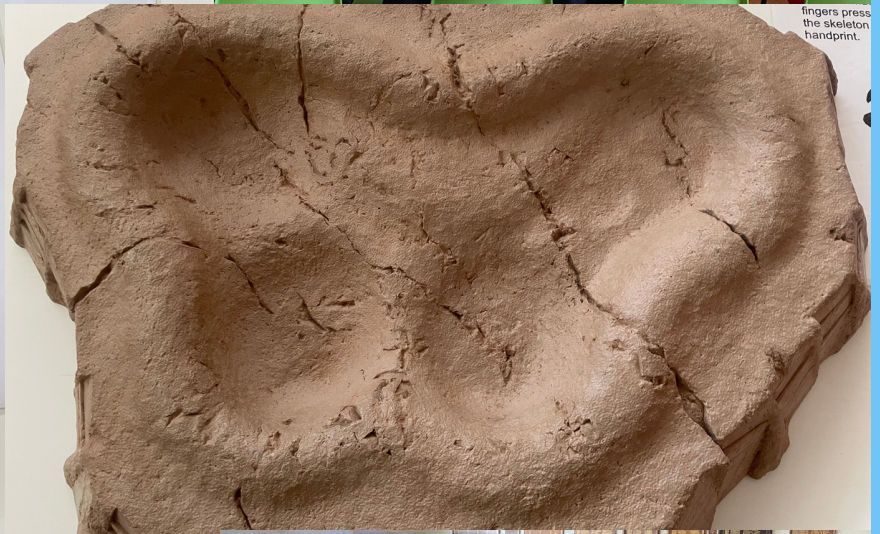
Thank you to the team at Paestan Canoe Hire for a wonderful day out. We learned lots of valuable information and skills!



Students learnt about and got to touch the fossil of a triceratops that is about 67 million years old.

From the Cretaceous period, found in Montana USA. It is the most complete triceratops ever found in history. 313 bones in total in a triceratops they found 267 bones of this one.

This fossil cost \$3 million for the Melbourne museum to purchase so it can be housed in Australia. We saw poo, teeth, claws, footprints, jawbones, horns and a head!
